Linguistic Ethnography

Drawing on US linguistic anthropology but infusing it with interdisciplinary and applied concerns of its own, linguistic ethnography has grown substantially in Britain and Europe over the last 15 years (>375 publications aligned with it explicitly in 2017, compared with just 2 in 2000).

This presentation (a) outlines its perspective and key concepts, (b) applies these in some data analysis, and maybe also (c) discusses LE's origins and inspiration.
