The development of online parsing in crosslinguistic context

Children need to parse their input in order to learn it, but traditionally the fields of language acquisition and online adult sentence processing have operated (mostly) independently of each other. In this talk I will present arguments for the value of examining children's online processing across development. I will present data from two projects that have examined online sentence processing in children acquiring Cantonese, Mandarin, and Tagalog as their first language, the results of which suggest that children, like adults, are sensitive to distributional statistics during online processing.
